DRINKING WATER PROBLEM CORRECTED

BOIL WATER ORDER LIFTED

Customers of the South Hadley Fire District No. 2 water system were notified on Wednesday, August 13, 2008 of a problem with our drinking water and were advised to boil water before using, or use bottled water, and to discard items prepared since August 11, 2008 with tap water. **It is no longer necessary to use boiled or bottled water for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes and preparing food.** The South Hadley Fire District No. 2, apologizes for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

Repeat water samples have been collected since *E. coli* were found in one water system sample on Tuesday, August 12, 2008. No *E. coli* were detected in those repeat samples. No total coliform bacteria have been detected since Thursday, August 14, 2008. South Hadley Fire District No. 2 will continue to disinfect the water system with increased chlorine levels as a precautionary measure. We will keep you informed if there are any additional concerns regarding your drinking water.

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection lifted the Boil Water Order on Saturday August Sixteenth, 2008 at Ten Seventeen A. M.
